The next highlight is the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Centre. This rescue Centre is home to bears, a musk ox herd, a wood bison herd that was once thought to be extinct, moose, an elk family, caribou herd, and more! Lunch is included at a local eatery at the base of the Chugach Mountains serving bottomless soup of the day, sourdough bread made daily, dessert and a beverage.
